

# Welcome to MACCRAY!

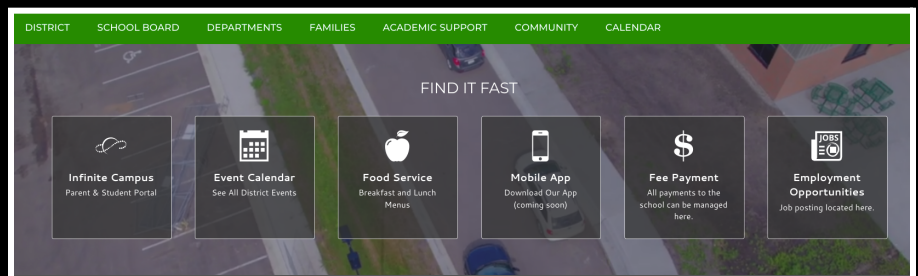

## Q: What is the school's laptop policy?

### **Chromebooks are a classroom tool!**

It is students' responsibility to:

- Bring their chromebooks to school everyday fully charged.
- Take proper care of their chromebook
  - Be gentle! Chromebooks can and will break if you are rough with them.
- GoGuardian filter and monitoring will be used to track students' internet use.

**Q: What is the school's Cell Phone Policy?**

- ✓ Cell phones are NOT allowed to be used during class or in the halls.
- ✓ 10th-12th grade students MUST check cell phones into classroom cubbies during class time.
- ✓ 6th-9th grade students MUST keep cell phones in their lockers.
- ✓ Students may check their phones in between classes and at lunch.
- ✓ If students do not follow the cell phone rules phones will be confiscated and PARENTS will be required to pick it up.



**Q: How do I register for activities?**

- Athletes must have a current sports qualifying physical exam on file in the Activities Office. Physicals are good for 3 years from the date of your last physical.
